Dr. Stephen C. Peiper, MD, is a Pathologist in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. His subspecialties include General Pathology, Anatomic Pathology, Hematopathology, and Molecular Genetics. Dr. Peiper graduated from the Saint Louis University School of Medicine in 1977, before completing his internship, residency, and fellowship at the University of North Carolina Hospitals. In 2008, Dr. Peiper was appointed chairman of the Department of Pathology, Anatomy, and Cell Biology at Jefferson Medical College of Thomas Jefferson University. He was also the chairman of the Department of Pathology at the Medical College of Georgia.

Along with his numerous other achievements, Dr. Peiper was the founder of the Biorepository Alliance of Georgia for Oncology, which established a statewide tumor bank. Prior to his work at the Medical College of Georgia, Dr. Peiper was a professor in the departments of Pathology, Biochemistry, and Molecular Biology at the University of Louisville in Kentucky, where he was the founder of the University's MD/PhD program. Some of his other roles there included Professor in the Department of Surgery, Vice-chairman in the Department of Pathology, and Founding Director for the Center of Genetics and Molecular Medicine. For his wealth of experience and knowledge, Dr. Peiper is the author of more than 140 peer-reviewed publications and more than 30 book chapters and symposia. Dr. Peiper is currently serving patients within Jefferson University Physicians.
