Dr. Kenneth R. Ong, MD, MPH, FACP, FIDSA, FHIMSS, is a highly experienced and acclaimed Clinical Informatics Consultant in Douglaston, New York. Dr. Ong attended the University of Michigan, The Honors College, graduating with his Bachelor of Science Degree in 1972. His illustrious career in medicine began in 1976, when he graduated from Wayne State University School of Medicine. Upon earning his Medical Degree, Dr. Ong completed his Categorical Medicine internship at Brooklyn Hospital, followed by his Family Medicine residency at Montefiore Hospital. He then undertook an additional residency at LaGuardia Hospital, where he served as Chief Medical Resident, prior to his fellowship training in Infectious Disease at St. Luke's/Roosevelt Hospital. Furthermore, Dr. Ong attended Columbia University School of Public Health, where he graduated in 1993 from the Executive Master's of Public Health Program. Due to his success and experience, he has earned the coveted titles of Fellow of the Infectious Disease Society of America, Fellow of the American College of Physicians, Fellow of the New York Academy of Medicine, Fellow of the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society, and Diplomate of the Clinical Informatics Board. Dr. Ong obtained board certification in Clinical Informatics, Infectious Diseases, Internal Medicine, and Family Practice, and is also a Certified Professional in Healthcare Information and Management Systems.

Having worked as a Clinical Informatics Consultant for numerous years, Dr. Ong has served in several different positions throughout his acclaimed career. From 1984 to 1990, he served as the Assistant Medical Director of the AIDS Center Program at Saint Luke's/Roosevelt Hospitals, and there after in 1990 served as Deputy Commissioner of Disease Intervention with the New York City Department of Health, a position he held until 1992. In 1993, Dr. Ong served as Director of Infectious Disease Clinics, as an Attending Physician at the Catholic Medical Center of Brooklyn-Queens, and Director of Medical Informatics within Saint Vincent Catholic Medical Center. In 2007, he joined the North Shore-LIJ Health System, serving as Director of Medical Informatics until 2009, before working in Medical Informatics at the Catholic Health Services of Long Island until 2010. Conclusively, Dr. Ong would serve as Chief Medical Informatics Officer at New York-Presbyterian/Queens, until 2016 in which he retired from practice. Calling upon his wealth of experience and knowledge, Dr. Ong also served as Adjunct Faculty at Columbia University's Mailman School of Public Health from 2005 to 2012, his Medical Informatics class having been voted one of the top classes offered in 2005. Retired as of 2016, Dr. Ong presently engages in, and is passionate about volunteer activity. He performs Music & Dance for Sunnyside Community Services Center's Adult Day Care Program for Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia, and also sings and plays acoustic guitar for Brandywine Care Assisted Living's Reflection Program for Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia. Furthermore, Dr. Ong serves on the Alzheimer's Association New York Chapter's October 2017 Queens Walkathon Committee.
